
Welcome!

On behalf of the College of Bishops and the General Church Board, a Framework has been released regarding the Ordination Way Forward. The Framework can be accessed here: way forward framework or via the LCA website under the heading 'Projects'. The congregation will consider this over the next few months. A limited number of printed copies are available on the table in the narthex.

General Convention of Synod Homestay Hosts

The LCANZ will hold its Convention of General Synod in October this year at Concordia College and to reduce financial costs, the General Synod planning team is looking for interest in members of suburban congregations to host a delegate travelling alone or a delegate and their spouse.

Homestay hosts would supply accommodation, including bedding, and may supply some meals (breakfast daily and some dinners). Those willing to serve in this way must have home and contents insurance. Delegates requesting homestays will be matched with willing hosts, taking into account considerations including pet or other allergies, dietary requirements, mobility requirements, and access to transport to and from the venue, noting that some delegates in homestays may have their own transport.
